Assignments of Error

- A. The trial court erred in holding that as a matter of law the plaintiff (Barbour) failed to establish a prima facie case, and the trial court's order granting the motion of the defendant (Carilion) to strike Barbour's case was in error.
- B. The trial court erred as a matter of law in holding that as a matter of law, and based on facts established in the plaintiff's evidence, the plaintiff was guilty of contributory negligence.
