Policy Regarding Use of Electronic Devices in Courtroom

Electronic devices containing information or evidence may be permitted in the courtroom subject to the following condition:

- Upon entering the Courthouse the party desiring to utilize such a device shall display and present the device to and inform the Deputy at the metal detector that it contains information/evidence that is needed in court. The Deputy will then take measures to secure the device and make it available at the hearing(s) as needed.
- 2) Failure to strictly follow the above-stated procedure will result in the denial of any request to use electronic devices in the courtroom. Please note: after hearings have commenced the court will generally not be in a position to wait for litigants or witnesses to retrieve devices from his/her vehicle or other places where they may be stored.
