1. Copies
 - a. Original – filed with the court where the judgment was rendered.
2. Prepared by judgment creditor.
3. Attachments – none.
4. Preparation details
 - a. This form can be used by a judgment creditor to note the satisfaction of a judgment. The form is completed by the judgment creditor and filed with the court.
 - b. This form is not a mandatory form. The judgment creditor may file a notice of satisfaction in another format as long as it contains the required information.

Data Elements

1. Name of locality and check box for the appropriate court.
2. Court address.
3. Amount of judgment rendered.
4. Date on which the judgment was entered.
5. Court in which the judgment was entered.
6. Date on which judgment was satisfied.
7. Date signed by the judgment creditor, attorney or agent.
8. Signature of judgment creditor, attorney or agent.
9. Date signature acknowledged (not required).
10. Signature of person acknowledging signature (not required).
11. If acknowledged by a notary public, all enclosed fields must be completed (not required).
12. Court case number.
13. Judgment creditor's name, address and telephone number.
14. Judgment debtor's name, address and telephone number.
