THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT OF VIRGINIA HAS DECLARED A JUDICIAL EMERGENCY IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 EMERGENCY.

AS A RESULT OF THIS ORDER, THE ALLEGHANY COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT CLERK'S OFFICE, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND CONTINUING UNTIL APRIL 6, 2020 WILL BE SUSPENDING SERVICES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1). THE PROCESSING OF PASSPORTS;
- 2) THE PROCESSING AND ISSUANCE OF CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMITS;
- 3) AND, THE ISSUANCE OF HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES AND,
- 4) ASSISTING PUBLIC WITH RECORD RESEARCH

FOR THOSE CITIZENS WHO DO NOT NEED TO ENTER THE COURTHOUSE WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO GO ONLINE TO ACCESS SERVICES WHERE POSSIBLE (I.E. PAYMENTS OF COURT COSTS, SECURE REMOTE ACCESS TO RESEARCH LAND RECORD INFORMATION and CASE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR ONGOING CASE INFORMATION STATUS).
