COURT DECLARED JUDICIAL EMERGENCY


Whereas on March 16, 2020, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Virginia issued an order declaring a judicial emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic suspending all non-essential, non-emergency cases until April 6, 2020, it is hereby ORDERED that all cases, with the exception of bond hearings and protective orders, are CONTINUED unless otherwise disposed of by written motion. The clerk is ORDERED to provide notice of hearing to impacted individuals of the new court date and time. Bond hearings, protective orders, and any other emergency matters brought by written motion and as permitted by the Court will be heard on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays at 10 AM and Wednesdays at 9 AM through April 6, 2020. Clerks offices shall remain open during the period of judicial emergency.
