

**Third Announcement from the Orange County Juvenile Court Concerning the  
Judicial Emergency**

**March 24, 2020**

Consistent with the Order of the Orange County Circuit Court entered March 23, 2020, the Orange Juvenile and Domestic Relations clerk's office will be closed to the public from March 23, 2020, through March 30, 2020. However, the clerk's office will make every effort to remain operational and provide essential services while balancing the health and safety needs of court visitors and personnel.

Consistent with the Virginia Supreme Court Order Declaring a Judicial Emergency from March 16, 2020 through April 6, 2020, the Orange JDR Court will be operating on a limited basis and there will be limited access to the building
