



General District Courts

1. If your fines and costs are not paid in full or a deferred payment plan is not entered into within 90 days of the date of your conviction, your account will accrue interest and/or a collection fee.
2. A payment plan that extends beyond 90 days from the date of conviction will incur an additional fee of \$10.00 that is added to your account. **No down payment is required for the first payment plan that is set up.**
3. If your total fines and costs are \$500.00 or less, you will be set up on a 6-month payment plan. If your total fines and costs are \$500.00 or more, you will be set up on a 12-month payment plan.
4. If subsequent payment plans are needed, then a down payment is required. If the total fines and costs are \$500.00 or less, a 10% down payment is required and you will be given 6 months to pay it. If fines and costs total more than \$500.00, the down payment is \$50.00 or 5%, whichever is greater, and you will be given 12 months to pay it.
5. No extensions can be granted by the Clerks' office.
6. You may petition the Court for modification of your payment plan. A modification may be granted by the Judge if good cause is shown.
7. If you default on your payment plan, you will incur additional collection fees and interest.
