TIME TO PAY DEFERRED PAYMENT AGREEMENTS

Pursuant to §19.2-354 of the *Code of Virginia*, the Hampton Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court has authorized the clerk to establish and approve conditions of all deferred payment agreements, pursuant to guidelines established by the Court.

- A \$10.00 fee will apply to each Time to Pay Deferred Payment Agreement entered into with the court.
- A date certain will be established for total payment in full at the time you enter into a Time to Pay Deferred Payment Agreement with the court. You may make periodic payments during the deferred time period, but must pay the balance in full on or before the deferred payment "due by" date.
- A defendant who enters into a Time to Pay Deferred Payment Agreement shall promptly inform the court of any change of mailing address during the term of the agreement.
- Pursuant to §19.2-358 of the *Code of Virginia*, the court may require a defendant to show cause why he should not be confined in jail or fined for non-payment. In addition, the account will be reported electronically to the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles as delinquent/unpaid.
- If a defendant defaults on a Time to Pay Deferred Payment Agreement and his driver's license is subsequently suspended by the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles, he may enter into a new Time to Pay Deferred Payment Agreement with the court and, after payment of the reinstatement fee to the Department of Motor Vehicles, have his driver's license restored once more.
