

VIRGINIA: IN THE JUVENILE & DOMESTIC RELATIONS COURT OF NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY

TIME TO PAY POLICY/AGREEMENT

If a defendant appearing before the Northumberland County Juvenile and Domestic Court is unable to pay the fines/costs imposed by the court within 30 days of the initial assessment date, the Clerk of this Court is authorized to permit the defendant to enter into a deferred or installment payment plan.

A one-time fee of \$10.00 shall be assessed against the defendant.

A \$20.00 down payment shall be required for a defendant to enter into an installment plan. The defendant shall continue paying \$20.00 per month until payment has been paid in full.

No down payment shall be required for a deferred plan. The defendant shall be granted an additional 90 days to complete paying the fines/costs from the initial due date. If the defendant has not paid the full amount within 90 days, but has made steady payments, the defendant may then enter into a new agreement to extend the deadline for an additional 90 days.

The defendant shall be required to sign a new DC-210 to enter into agreement.

No interest shall accrue during the time period the agreement is in effect and/or payment plan does not default.
