Assignments of Error

- 1. The trial court erred when it failed to recognize a lengthy term-of-years sentence as the functional equivalent of a life sentence without parole. The Court of Appeals erred when it affirmed.
- 2. The trial court erred when it refused to distinguish the holding of *Angel v. Commonwealth* in light of *Miller v. Alabama* and *Montgomery v. Louisiana*. The Court of Appeals erred when it affirmed.
- 3. The trial court erred when it sentenced the defendant to the functional equivalent of a life sentence without parole for a non-homicide offense in contravention of *Graham v. Florida*. The Court of Appeals erred when it affirmed.
- 4. The trial court erred when it sentenced Randy Ross to the functional equivalent of a life sentence without parole and failed to find that Randy Ross was irreparably incorrigible as required by *Miller v. Alabama* and *Montgomery v. Louisiana*. The Court of Appeals erred when it affirmed.
