Assignment of Error

2. The trial court erroneously granted VNG's motion in limine to exclude all of Colonna's evidence on residue damages, including all of the evidence listed in Colonna's 4-27-20 proffer. This evidence related to safety issues and their effect on the property's value. This evidence included damaging admissions by VNG, expert testimony about the cost to adjust the site to account for the presence of a high-pressure gas line, and the diminution of the property's value to prospective purchasers.
