Assignment of Error

The Court of Appeals erred in invoking the approbate/reprobate doctrine to prevent Mr. Page from arguing a distinction between the City of Portsmouth and PRHA in executing respective governmental and proprietary functions. The Court of Appeals erred in affirming the trial court's finding that PRHA acted in a governmental capacity rather than a proprietary capacity when PRHA maintained a nuisance the City ordered remedied.
