In addition, you must pay all costs and fines through the clerk's office of this court and perform all other parts of the district court's punishment.

Civil Cases: If you wish to withdraw your appeal, you must file in circuit court a written notice of intent to withdraw your appeal, and serve, in person or by first-class mail all other parties or their counsel. If any party files a timely written objection to the withdrawal of your appeal, you may be denied permission to withdraw.

NOTICE ABOUT COURT COSTS AND FEES IN APPEALS OF CRIMINAL AND TRAFFIC CASES - Court costs and fees in the circuit court will be assessed in cases resulting in conviction of a misdemeanor not originally charged as a felony, a deferred disposition of proceedings, a referral to a driver improvement clinic or traffic school in lieu of a finding of guilt for a traffic infraction, or proof of compliance with law under § 46.2-104, requiring a driver's license or permit and registration, and § 46.2-1157, requiring safety inspection and correction of defects of motor vehicles. These costs and fees shall be in addition to any fee assessed in the district court.
